

Château Pichon-Bellevue Dry White

The Graves de Vayres are situated in the extreme north of the Entre-Deux-Mers region. It is a zone of gravel soil in the middle of a vast region of clay limestone soil. This explains the word "Graves" in the name of this AOC. Since 1880, our family's vineyard has grown from 2 ha to 50 ha. Located in the heart of the appellation Graves de Vayres, we produce red and white wines but also rosé.
