History

Château de Barre is the third estate of Pierre Jean Larraqué Vineyards. Settled on the prestigious clay and gravels terroir of Graves de Vayres, Château Barre is a place steeped with history. Its vinification cellar, entirely composed of concrete tanks, is located in a cathedral like building. In the beautiful garden, an orangery and a chapel built in the 18th century contributes to the unique charme of the estate.
